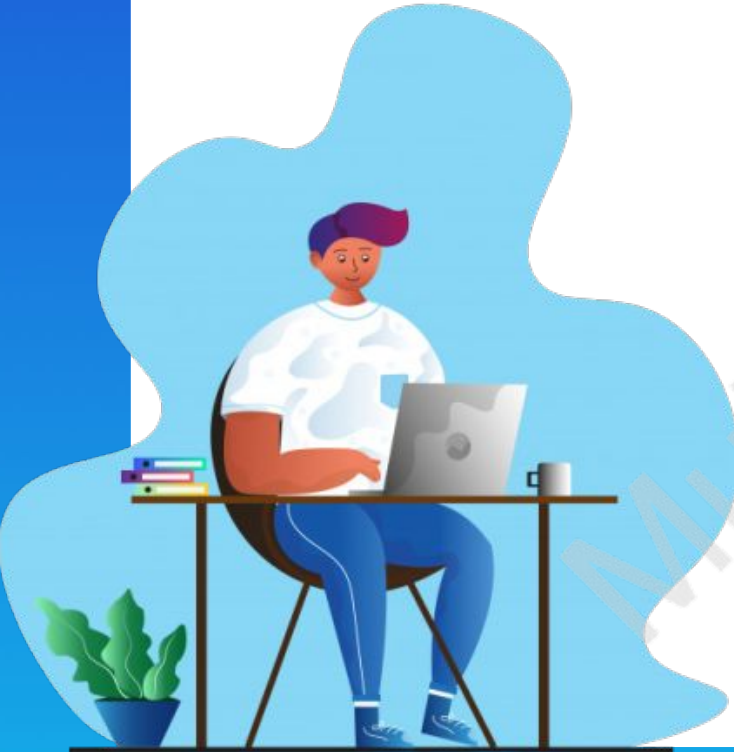


SER- to be



Class Objective

To understand the irregular verb
SER (to be).





Concept A:



In Spanish, the two irregular verbs: SER and ESTAR both mean 'to be' but they are used very differently. In this lesson we'll be learning about SER.



Concept B:

The conjugation of the verb 'SER' (to be).

Yo	soy
Tú	eres
Él / Ella / Usted	es
Nosotros / Nosotras	somos
Vosotros / Vosotras	sois
Ellos / Ellas / Ustedes	son



Concept B:

SER is used when we're talking about characteristics of a person/object or fairly permanent quality

Example:

1. Mi hermano es alto. (My brother is tall)

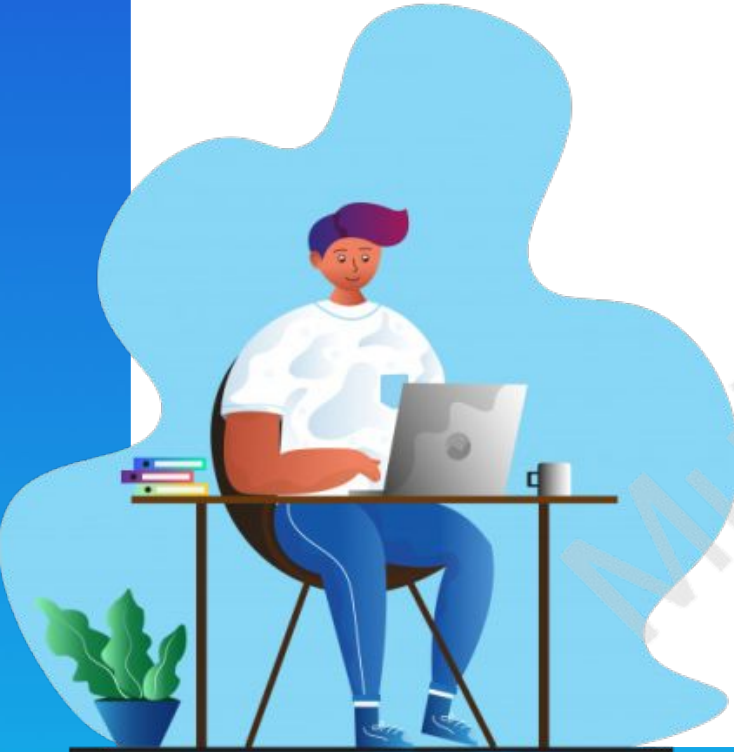
2. Ella es muy guapo. (She is very pretty)
