



Talking about likes and dislikes

Let's learn to talk about likes and dislikes!





Class Objective

To understand the concept of Gustar and able to say about your likes and dislikes in Spanish.



Concept A

To express likes and dislikes, the verb GUSTAR is used in Spanish. The verb ENCANTAR is used to talk about things you really like or love.

<u>Conjugation for the verbs:</u>

Pronouns	GUSTAR	ENCANTAR	Pronouns
Yo	Gusto	Encanto	Yo
Tú	Gustas	Encantas	Tú
Él/ella/usted	Gusta	Encanta	Él/ella/usted
Nosotros/as	Gustamos	Encantamos	Nosotros/as
Vosotros/as	Gustais	Encantais	Vosotros/as
Ellos/ellas/ustedes	Gustan	Encantan	Ellos/ellas/ustedes



Concept A

Since the subject of the sentence must be either singular (book) or plural (books), the only forms of gustar you will use are "gusta" and "gustan."

Me gusta el libro. I like the book. Te gusta el libro.



Concept A



Gusta or Gustan does not match the subject, but instead what is liked.



Concept B:

The verbs GUSTAR & ENCANTAR are NOT preceded by a subject pronoun. Instead, these verbs preceded by indirect object pronouns (Me, Te, Le, Nos, Os, and Les).
