Brexit

La salida del Reino Unido de la Unión Europea, comúnmente abreviada como brexit, (unión de la palabras inglesas Britain y exit, 'Gran Bretaña' y 'salida'), es una meta política perseguida por determinados partidos políticos, grupos civiles y personas del Reino Unido, que buscan que su país abandone la Unión Europea (UE). Salir de la Unión Europea es un derecho de los Estados miembros en virtud del artículo 50 del Tratado de la Unión Europea. Ya en 1975 se había celebrado un referéndum sobre la permanencia del país en la Comunidad Económica Europea, precursora de la UE, con resultado favorable a la permanencia. En 2016 se produjo un nuevo referéndum sobre la pertenencia, que se celebró el jueves 23 de junio y arrojó un resultado favorable a la salida de la Unión Europea con casi un 52 % de los votos, frente a un 48 % que abogó por la permanencia.²
