#### **Concept A: Introduction**

- Understand the poem- titles, words

- Try to find out the theme of the poem
- Find out what is the poem all about- eg- conversation, an experience, speakers view etc
- Find if there is any message the poet wants to give
- Trace the literary devices, figure of speech used in the poem
- Paraphrase stanza wise or create a summary of the poem.
