

Talk about habits

Class objective: To be able to speak about habits of yours in Spanish using some of the regular words.

Concept A: HABLAR DE HÁBITOS (TALK ABOUT HABITS)

→ **(No) Es normal / habitual / frecuente / raro** + infinitivo

→ **Lo normal / habitual es** + infinitivo

Ejemplos:

- En España **lo normal es pagar** a escote.
(In Spain the normal thing is to pay a neckline.)
- En mi país **no es muy habitual tomar** café después de las comidas.
(In my country it is not very common to drink coffee after meals.)

Para hablar de hábitos usamos también **soler** + infinitivo.

	SOLER	
Yo	Suelo	
Tú	Sueles	
Él/ella/usted	Suele	+ infinitivo
Nosotros/as	Solemos	
Vosotros/as	Soléis	
Ellos/ellas/ustedes	Suelen	

Por ejemplo:

→ En España la gente **suele acostarse** tarde.

(In Spain people usually go to bed late.)

Para opinar, valorar o aconsejar, podemos usar esta estructura.

(To give an opinion, value or advise, we can use this structure.)

Es bueno / malo / aconsejable / interesante / fácil + infinitivo

En mi país **es aconsejable dejar** un 10% de propina.

(In my country it is advisable to leave a 10% tip.)
