Concept A: What is arguing and debating?

- ¿Qué significa argumentar?

Argumentar es una modalidad del discurso (como narrar, describir etc). Se argumenta cuando se aportan razones para defender una opinión. Argumentar es la capacidad que tienen los seres humanos para sacar conclusiones y resolver problemas.

(To argue is a type of speech such as to narrate and to describe. One argues when they provide reasons to defend an opinion. To argue is a capacity that human beings possess to derive conclusions and to resolve problems.)



- ¿Qué significa debatir?

Debatir es una acción en la que dos o más personas exponen sus opiniones o puntos de vista en torno a un tema determinado.

(To debate is an action in which two or more people express their opinions or point of views around a specific topic.)



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
