Concept A :

Nominativ : This case is used for writing the subject in a sentence.

The articles for Nominativ is given below:

Masculine	Feminine	Neuter	plural
Der	Die	Das	Die

Example:

1. M : Der Mann ist klug (The man is clever)
2. F : Die Frau ist nett (The lady is nice)
3. N: Das Kind ist intelligent (The child is intelligent)



Concept B:

Akkusativ:

1. This case is used for objects. An Object can be anything, a person or a thing.
2. This case is also used for showing movement
3. This case comes when certain prepositions or verbs are used

The articles for Akkusativ are given below:

Masculine	Feminine	Neuter	plural
Den	Die	Das	Die



Concept B :

Example:

M: Ich habe den Mann gesehen.

F : Ich suche die Frau

N: Ich finde das Kind schön.



Concept C :

Dativ:

1. This is used for indirect Object
2. This is also used for stationary objects (objects with no movement)
3. Dative case comes when certain prepositions or verbs come
