# **Class Objective**

#### Concept A:

The possessive pronouns are the words we use to show possession. Unlike possessive adjectives, they do not proceed as a noun, but replace it.

For example this is a possessive adjective sentence:

Das ist mein Stift! (That's my pencil)

Whereas this is a possessive pronoun sentence:

Nein, er ist meinen! (No, its mine)



## Concept B: Here is a quick look at the basic form of the German possessive pronouns:

pronouns	possessive pronouns	English meaning
ich	mein	mine
du	dein	yours
er	sein	his
sie	ihr	her's



## Concept B: Here is a quick look at the basic form of the German possessive pronouns:

es	sein	its
wir	unser	ours
ihr	euer	yours
sie	ihr	theirs
Sie	Ihr	yours



### Concept B: Here is a quick look at the basic form of the German possessive pronouns:

The possessive pronouns are what is known as der words. This means they have to take the same endings as their corresponding definite article. These endings are dependent on the gender and number of the noun the possessive pronoun is replacing, and which case the noun belongs to.
