Zweiteilige Konnektoren	Function
Nicht nur.....sondern auch	Positive Aufzählung
Sowohl.....als auch	Positive Aufzählung
Zwar.....aber	Einschränkung(positive↔negative)
Entweder.....oder	Positive Aufzählung
Einerseits.....andererseits	Gegensatz
Weder.....noch	Negative Aufzählung



Concept A. What are zweiteilige konnektoren?

- While connecting two sentences with zweiteilige Konnektor, the two clauses are called Hauptsatz 1 and Hauptsatz 2. Sometimes in Hauptsatz 1, konnektor 1 is either at position 1 or position 3, and in hauptsatz 2, konnektor 2 is at position 0.
