A phrasal verb is formed by a combination of a verb and an adverb or preposition, for example 'let go', "let down "which together gives a different meaning. Phrasal verbs are phrases that indicate actions and are used in spoken English and informal texts.

In a sentence, if the words that have been used **together** (verb+adverb/preposition) then it's a phrasal verb.
