Concept A : Revision of Basics of Hindi

An Introduction to Alphabets

- The Hindi alphabet is also known as the Devanagari alphabet and contains 48 characters on the basis of pronunciation. On the basis of writing there are 52 alphabets.
- Hindi contains 13 vowels, 2 symbols, 36 constants, and has no upper and lower case of each letter.
- Hindi letters are written left to right and linked together by lines through the top of each letter.
