Concept B: Talking about television programs

1. Est-ce que vous regardez la télévision ? (Do you watch the TV?)
 - a. Pas tellement. (Not Much.)
 - b. Ben, oui, bien-sûr. (yes, of course)
2. Quelle chaîne mettez-vous, normalement ? (Which channel do you put, normally?)
 - a. Je préfère TV 5. (I prefer TV5.)
 - b. Je mets souvent la quatre.(I often put the 4.)
 - c. C'est Canal +pour moi. (It is Canal + for me.)

- a) J'aime bien le feuilleton "Des amis". (I like the soap Friends a lot.)

 - d) Talk-show d'Oprah Winfrey, je ne le rate jamais. (Oprah Winfrey's talk show, I never miss it.)
