Concept A: Partizip 1 - Definition and explanation

The Partizip I is a form of word that is derived from verbs. It can have different functions in a sentence. For example, the Partizip I can be used as an adjunction, an adverb or a noun. Let's have a closer look to how the Partizip I can affect our sentences.

In German we can form the Partizip I with every verb. All we have to do is to add the letter -d to the infinitive present form of the verb, e.g.



Concept A: Partizip 1 - Definition and explanation

- schreiben (to write) -> schreibend (writing)
- lachen (to laugh) -> lachend (laughing)
- spielen (to play) -> spielend (playing)



Concept B: Construction of Partizip I

Partizip I is constructed with:

(INFINITIVE OF THE VERB) + "d"

Verb	Partizip I
haben	habend
koennen	koennend
singen	singend



Concept B: Construction of Partizip I

There are 2 verbs that don't follow this rule:

Verb	Partizip I
sein	seinend
tun	tuend

sein and **tun** are the only verbs in German that do not end with “en”, “ln” or with “rn” and that is why they form the Partizip I differently.
