DIFFERENCES BETWEEN ADJECTIVES AND ADVERBS

CLASS OBJECTIVE: Learn the different aspects of Adverbs and adjectives in Russian Grammar and their differences.

CONCEPT A: Difference in the usage of Adverbs and Adjectives in a sentence.

Adverbs are used to qualify verbs, adjectives and other Adverbs as well. Adverbs don't agree with the number, case and gender of the verbs, and Adjectives.

Examples:

Он медленно работает.

He works **slowly**.

Он свободно говорит по-русски.

He fluently speaks in Russian.

While adjectives qualify only nouns and pronouns. All adjectives in Russian Grammar must satisfy the number, gender and case of the noun or pronoun.

Examples:

Она добрая девушка.

She is a **kind** girl.

Это современное здание.

It is a **modern** building.

CONCEPT B: Formation of adverbs from different parts of speech.

Adverbs derived from Nouns.

- Ночь- Ночью(During night)
- Вечер- Вечером(In evening)
- Утро- Утром(In morning)
- Лето- Летом(During summer)
- Осень- Осенью(During Autumn)
- Зима- Зимой (During Winter)

Examples:

- Летом я иду в Гоу.
- In summer, I go to Goa.
