**Learning objective:** We will go through the nouns and pronouns deeply and carefully as well learn its usage along with some basic rules.

Concept A- A basic information about nouns and pronouns in Urdu language.

- In Urdu there are only two genders: masculine and feminine. It is very difficult for a new user to differentiate between the two genders easily. There are some tricks to find out about them.
- Masculine Nouns: Nouns ending in aa are normally masculine.
- Feminine Nouns: Nouns ending in ii are normally feminine.

Masculine Nouns	Feminine Nouns
( Dada ) دادا	دادی ( Dadi )
چچا ( Chacha )	جچى ( Chachi )
پوپها ( Phupha )	پوپهی ( Phuphi )
نانا ( Nana )	نانی ( Nani )

دادا/ نانا - Grandfather دادی/ نانی - Grandmother چچا/ پهوپها - Uncle چچی/ پهوپهی - Aunty

### **Concept B- Urdu Pronouns**

There are various types of pronouns, each with its significance in the Urdu language. Relative pronouns, possessive pronouns, intensive, interrogative, demonstrative, indefinite pronouns, and personal pronouns are some of the Urdu pronouns.

#### **Personal Pronouns**

Pronouns primarily linked with one of three grammatical persons, first, second, or third Person, are called personal pronouns. Number, grammatical or natural gender form all influence the appearance of personal pronouns. Conjugated verbs following the pronouns are used according to the situation and mood.
