Past Continuous الفعل الماضى الاستمراري

Class objective : We are going to learn past continuous tense and its usage along with how to make it .

Concept A- how to describe past continuous in Arabic.

- The past continuous shows us that the action was already in progress at a certain time in the past.
- In Arabic language we use " كان " as a helping verb with simple present tense to make past continuous as below:

كان + يفعل

• So now we have two verbs, one is main verb and second one is helping verb and both should be conjugated. کان is conjugated like simple past and the main verb is conjugated like simple present tense.
