VERB ENDING - FUTURE TENSE(겠습니다/겠다)

Class objective:

I will be able to understand the use of Verb Ending In Future Tense

CONCEPT A: Introduction to verb ending - future tense

Future tense is easy, and is simply a matter of adding "~겠다" to the stem of a word.

Unlike the past and present tense. there is no difference if the stem ends in a vowel or a consonant.

겠습니다=겠다

- 나는 먹다(nanun moktha) = I eat. (*unconjugated*) 나는 먹겠다 = I will eat(nanun mogeathsamnida)
- 나는 가다(nanun gada) = I go. (*unconjugated*) 나는 가겠다(nanun gagaethsamnida) = I will go.
- 나는 배우다(nanun paeuda) = I learn. (*unconjugated*) 나는 배우겠다(nanun paeugaetha) = I will learn.
- 나는 행복하겠다 = I will be happy. (nanun haenbokhhagaetha)
- 그것은 맛있겠다 = That thing will be delicious.(ghgosan mashigaetha)
- 나는 배고프겠다 = I will be hungry. (naun phaegophgaeththa)
- 나는 내일 학교에 가겠다.=I am going to school tomorrow.(naun nael hakyoae ghagaetha)

Concept B: Verbs ending with vowels and consonants

Instead of 겠습니다/겠다 we can also use 을거예요.

If its ending with

● vowel, we will use - = 거예요

• consonant, we will use - 을거예요

그것은 맛있을 거예요 = That thing will be delicious.(ghagosan mashil koaeo)

나는 배고플 거예요 = I will be hungry.(nanun phaegophal koaeo)

나는 내일 학교에 갈 거예요. = I am going to school tomorrow.(naun nael hakyoae ghal koaeo)

난 먹을 거에요 = I will probably eat.(nan mogal koaeo)

난 갈 거에요 = I will probably go.(nan ghal koaeo)
