Class Objective: I'll be able to learn the grammar: A/V/N-(으)ㄴ/늗데도.

Concept A: Introduction:

This expression is used to introduce a clause that indicates an opposite or an unexpected state of affairs when compared to the information given in the preceding clause.

This expression is a combination of $\sim (2) - / \equiv \square$ (which describes the situation under discussion), and $\sim \square / \square \subseteq \square$ (which indicates concession or contrast).

This expression corresponds to 'although / in spite of / despite the fact that / even though / still' in English.

It shows a stronger contrast and emphasizes the nuance of "even though."

Sentence pattern for using this grammar will be:

● For nouns, Past : ~였는데도

• For nouns, Present : ~인데도

• For adjectives, Past : ~았/었는데도

● For adjectives, Present : ~(으) 느데도

● For verbs, Past : ~았/었는데도

• For verbs, Present : ~는데도

Concept B: A-ㄴ/은데, N-인데, V-는데 and ~아/어도

먹고 싶은데 돈이 없어서 못 먹어요 = I want to eat but I have no money so I can't.
