Concept A: Grammar

きっと/たぶん/もしかしたら

1. きっと

This adverb indicates that the speaker is quite certain of what he/she is saying. The probability ranges from quite high to the same level as that of ~でしょう.

ミラーさんは きっと 来(き)ます。

Mr. Miller will surely come.

あしたは きっと 雨(あめ)でしよう。

It will undoubtedly rain tomorrow.

2. たぶん

This adverb entails less certainty than きっと, and is mostly used with ~でしょう. As shown in the second example below たぶんis very often used with ~と おもいます.

- ミラーさんは 来(く)るでしょうか。
- ・・たぶん来(く)るでしょう。

Do you think Mr. Miller will come?

- ••I guess so.
- 山田(やまだ)さんは この ニュースを たぶん 知(し)らないと 思(おも)います。

I guess Mr. Yamada does not know this news.
