Concept A: Vocabulary needed to discuss the topic:

- Subscribe- to give consent
- Internet- vast network that connects computers all over the world
- Web Series- is a series of scripted or non-scripted online videos, generally in episodic form
- Youtube- a video sharing service where users can watch, like, share, comment and upload or watch the videos.
- Sitcom- a television series that involves a continuing cast of characters in a succession of comedic circumstances
- Episode- part of a sequence of a TV series, usually 30 to 60 minutes long
- Seasons- a set or sequence of related television programmes; a series.
- TRP rating- TRP or Television Rating Point is the tool use to check which programmes are watched the most and to index the viewers' choices
- Commercial- a television or radio advertisement.
- Series- a television show that tells a story over many episodes or seasons -

Concept B: Arguments supporting Web series

- A web series is a series of scripted or non-scripted online videos that can be watched either through smartphones, tablet, laptop or television.
- It is generally in episodic form, released on the Internet and part of the web television medium.
- It is basically a collection of episodes which is streamed through online platforms.
- These episodes could be related to each other or could be one long story split into multiple episodes.
- It first emerged in the late 1990s and became popular in the early 2000s.
- There are different web platforms for these e.g. youtube, Netflix, Amazon Prime where you can enjoy these web-series.
- Many of the web-series are absolutely free of cost on these online video streaming platforms.
- The most popular genres explored through a web-series are comedy and suspense-thrillers. Lately there are other shows as well.
- You can watch your favourite show at your own convenient time, as long as you have an internet connection.
- You can watch your show as many times as you want in a single day.
