## Concept A : Prepositions in Urdu.

Preposition in Urdu is known as 'Hurf jar' حروف جار

### Definition :

A preposition is a word placed before a noun. That word relates a noun or pronoun to another in the sentences.

حروف کا کسی نوں یا پرونوؤں کے ساتھ استعمال ہوتے ہیں اور انکا تعلق دوسرے الفاظ کے ساتھ ظاہر ہوتا ہیں

OR

A preposition is a word placed before a noun or non-equivalent show in what relation the pronoun or thing devoted there by stand to something due.

حروف جار وہ الفاظ ہیں جو ایک اسم کا دوسرے اسم ضمیر سے تعلق ظاہر کرتے ہیں انہی الفاظ کو حروف جار کہتے ہیں

Example : At, Under, On, In, From, To, With, By
