# Concept A : Days of the Week (Soptaaher dingulo) (সপ্তাহের দিনগুলো)

Day - Din (দিন)

Days - Dingulo (দিনগুলো)
Week - Soptaho (সপ্তাহ)
Sunday - Robibaar (রবিবার)
Monday - Sombaar (সোমবার)
Tuesday - Mongolbaar (মঙ্গলবার)
Wednesday - Budhbaar (বুধবার)

Thursday - Brihospotibaar (বৃহস্পতিবার)

Friday - Shukrobaar (শুক্রবার) Saturday - Shonibaar (শনিবার)

### Concept B: Let us see a few sentence examples using the days of the week

### **Example Sentences:**

I met him on Thursday. Ami taar sathe brihospotibaar dekha korechilaam. আমি তাঁর সাথে বৃহস্পতিবার দেখা করেছিলাম।

(Note: 'taar/ভাঁর' is used with elders to denote respect)

Let us go to the park on Sunday. Cholo robibaar aamra parke jaai. চলো রবিবার আমরা পার্কে যাই।

Come to our home on Monday. Sombaar aamader baarite aasben. সোমবার আমাদের বাডিতে আসবেন।
