

N+때문에, A/V+기 때문에 (Reason and cause)

Class Objective:

I'll be able to learn the grammar: N+때문에, A/V+기 때문에.

Introduction:

This expression is used to express the reason for or cause of the situation described in the second clause.

It can also be used when expressing a clear reason and is a more literary expression than -아/어서 and -(으)니까.

This expression corresponds to 'because (of)' in English.

Sentence pattern for using this grammar will be:

- For nouns, ~때문에 is added to the stem.
- For adjectives and verb, ~기 때문에 is added to the stem.

Concept A: Because of (때문)

- By placing '때문' after a noun, you can create the meaning of "because of (that noun)."
- Noun functions as the reason and the object of the sentence, not the subject

일 때문에 = Because of work

일 때문에 나는 너를 못 만날 것 같아 - Because of work, I probably won't be able to meet you

교복 때문에 아주 더워요 - I'm really hot because of my school uniform

별명 때문에 너의 진짜 이름을 깜빡했어 - I forgot your real name because of your nickname

- not the same as adding ~아/어서 to 이다.

일이라서... = Because it is work

한국어를 할 수 있는 일이라서 너무 좋아 - I can speak korean while working so i like the work

Concept B: Because/Therefore (~기 때문에) and N이기 때문에

- The clause before 때문에 must be in the form of a noun, and this is done by adding ~기

저는 배고프기 때문에 밥을 먹고 싶어요 = I want to eat because I am hungry

저는 배고파서 밥을 먹고 싶어요 = I want to eat because I am hungry
