- Dear Friend's Name
- Dear Mr./Miss.Surname (for eg-neighbour)
- Dear Aunty/Uncle/Granny/Grandpa
- Dear Mom/Dad

Concept B: The opening of informal letters can be casual and comforting.

Expressions:

- I hope this letter find you in good health.
- I hope you are doing well.
- How are you and your family?
- How are you? How have you been?
- How are things going on with you?

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
