CONCEPT A:



As the name suggests, conditional sentences express an action that can take place only if a certain condition is met. These sentences usually use the connector “Si” (If).



Examples:

- Si j'étais riche, je m'achèterais un château.

(If I were rich, I would buy myself a castle)

- Si j'ai soif, je bois de l'eau.

(If I am thirsty, I drink water)

- Si je suis en retard, attends-moi.

(If I'm late, wait for me.)



Examples:

- Elle ne savait pas les détails, si elle vous a dit cela.

(She didn't know the details, if she told you that.)



CONCEPT B: Types of conditional sentences



1. Real condition: the conditions that have a good chance of being fulfilled. In this type of conditional sentences, we use présent in the if-clause and in the main clause we use présent or futur simple.
