CONCEPT A:

- As the name suggests, conditional sentences express an action
- that can take place only if a certain condition is met. These
- sentences usually use the connector "Si" (If).



Examples:

• Si j'étais riche, je m'achèterais un château.

(If I were rich, I would buy myself a castle)

• Si j'ai soif, je bois de l'eau.

(If I am thirsty, I drink water)

• Si je suis en retard, attends-moi.

(If I'm late, wait for me.)



Examples:

• Elle ne savait pas les détails, si elle vous a dit cela.

(She didn't know the details, if she told you that.)



CONCEPT B: Types of conditional sentences

- 1. Real condition: the conditions that have a good chance of
- being fulfilled. In this type of conditional sentences, we use
- présent in the if-clause and in the main clause we use présent
- or futur simple.
