# Verb Ending-아/어/여 (Informal)

# Class Objective- TO HELP TO UNDERSTAND THE USE OF INFORMAL VERB ENDINGS.

## CONCEPT A: VERB ENDING 어(요).

- If the last syllable of the stem contains any vowel other than ੨, 아, and is not a ਰੋ⊦ ਪਾ verb then it becomes an ੀ. Note that verb stems with ੀ turn into a ੀ (see next section), it is due to a contraction of ੀ + ੀ = ਖੀ.
- If the last syllable of the stem contains the vowel 이 and there's no 받침, i.e. 시키다, then it becomes a 여 (시켜). The 여 is a result of the contraction between 이 + 어. The contracted form is almost always used in spoken and written Korean.
- Verbs that end in in the vowel ℍ don't get anything conjugated to it, i.e. 내다 → 내요.
