8. Playing system

Preliminary Stage:

Players ranked on the seeding list from 15-22 will play preliminary stage in 2 rounds.

Winners of preliminary round 2 matches will qualify for the Main Event.

Main Stage:

The competition will be played on a knockout basis of 16 players. All matches will be played best of 5 games.

Multiball playing system will be used.

9. Draw Procedure

Players who are directly qualified to Main Stage are determined according to Invitation List for this event.

The seeding list will be made according to the ETTU European January ranking. The January Ranking will determine the seeding order among the 14 players in the Main Draw and the eight players in the Preliminary Stage.

The Top 14 players directly qualified to Main Draw and 8 players who need to play Preliminary Stage are determined by the 2025 ETTU European December Ranking (ranking used for the Invitation List).

Draw Procedure:

Preliminary stage:

Seeded players from 15-18 will be placed in positions 1, 4, 5 and 8

Seeded players from 19 -22 will be placed in positions 2, 3, 6 and 7 $\,$

Main Stage:

Seeded players 1 and 2 will be placed in position 1 and 16

Seeded players 3 and 4 will be drawn by lot into position 8 and 9

Seeded players 5 to 8 will be drawn by lot into positions 4, 5, 12 and 13

All remaining players (including players from Preliminary round) will be drawn randomly to positions 2, 3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14 and 15

There shall be no separation by Association.

10. Participants

There shall be 22 players per gender qualified for the 2026 CCB Europe Top 16 Cup.

- a) The current European Champion
- b) The winner of the previous TOP 16 Cup
- c/1) MS The top 20 players from the most recent **ETTU European Ranking List (December 2025) published on 5.12.2025**, excluding the current European Champion/winner of the 2025 TOP 16 Cup
- c/2) WS The top 19 players from the most recent **ETTU European Ranking List (December 2025) published on 5.12.2025**, excluding the current European Champion and the winner of the 2025 TOP 16 Cup

d) If no players qualify from the Host Association then the Host Association shall nominate one Host Association player per gender

Only players being eligible to represent their National Association according to regulation 3.8 and 4.3.6 of the ITTF Handbook (eligibility at World title events) will be invited.

11. Participation confirmation

ETTU online entry system will be used (https://www.ttm.co.at/onlineentries/users/login)

Online entries will be open from **Monday, 15.12.2025**. **until Monday, 05.01.2026**. for invited players and reserve players. All reserve players wishing to participate in the tournament in case of qualified players withdrawals must be entered to OES until the deadline on **05.01.2026**.

In case of cancellations, ETTU will send confirmation of participation to the first reserve player(s) in the line on reserve list and being entered into OES.

12. Substitutions

Substitutions before the entry closing date shall be per entry regulations and according to the European Ranking List available on **05.12.2026. (December 2025 Ranking)**

- a) If the European Champion and/or the winner of the 2025 Top 16 Cup is not available or withdraws, he/she shall be replaced by the remaining highest ranked player from the European ranking.
- b) If the Host Association player is not available or withdraws, another player nominated by the Host Association shall replace him/her.
- c) If any other player is not available or withdraws, he/she shall be replaced by the remaining highest ranked player from the European ranking.

The first reserve player (man and woman) shall arrive 1 day before the qualification event draw and be present at the draw. ETTU shall reimburse to his/her parent Association the expenses (economic class travel and two nights in the official accommodation including entire board) of an invited reserve player who attends but is not required to play

In case of late cancellation of the players from Main Draw (after the Draw for the Qualification event, and before the Draw for Main Event), the position in the Main Draw shall be decided by lot between two losers of Round 2 Preliminary matches.

13. Draw and Press Conference

The Preliminary Stage Draw will take place on Wednesday 04.02. at 19:00 in the venue.

The Main Stage Draw will take place on Thursday, 05.02. at 20:00 in the venue.

It is the obligation of ALL players beeing drawn to attend the draw from the start to the end, for both Preliminary Stage and Main Stage.

Furthermore, all players will be required to attend a personal interview on-site if requested. For event and player promotion including photos and social media content, players must be available on Thursday (any activity would be max. 1 hour) around practice plans/schedule. If any extra ETTU activity is organized during the event, all players no longer in the competition must be available to participate if requested.

28. Information for participants (2)

In the context of betting participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever, infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct, or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition, or any part thereof, in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF Regulations 3.5.3.

29. Privacy policy

By registering and entering the 2026 CCB Europe TOP 16 Cup, each registered and entered person agrees and gives his/her consent to the ETTU Privacy Policy as laid down on the ETTU website (https://www.ettu.org/privacy-policy/).

*For persons being younger than 16 years, consent to the ETTU Privacy Policy is given by the holder of parental responsibility over the persons.

30. Printed names on the shirts

Players shall have their names printed on the back of their shirts. Players failing to compete with a t-shirt including their name printed on the back shall receive a fine of 100€ per match via their national Associations.

31. Levy

There shall be a levy of \le 300 per participating player payable to ETTU (Regulation H.4.2.)

32. Qualification for the ITTF World Cup

Travelling details deadline:

The 2026 CCB Europe Top 16 Cup will serve as a qualification for the ITTF Singles World Cup, which will take place from 30.03.-05.04.2026 in Macao. The 4 semifinalists at each men and women will be directly qualified.
