 Buck has been convicted of false statements in the acquisition of ammunition, causing false information to be entered into the records of a licensed dealer and making false statements with respect to Social Security Records.
CAUTION
 BUCK, A PRISON ESCAPEE, IS BEING SOUGHT IN CONNECTION WITH THE ARMED ROBBERY OF AN ARMORED TRUCK WHICH RESULTED IN THE KILLING OF TWO POLICE OFFICERS AND ONE GUARD AND THE WOUNDING OF ONE OFFICER AND TWO GUARDS. BUCK IS KNOWN TO ASSOCIATE WITH REVOLUTIONARY ORGANIZATIONS WHICH HAVE A GREAT PROPENSITY FOR CRIMINAL ACTIVITY AND VIOLENCE AGAINST LAW ENFORCEMENT. BUCK SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED, EXTREMELY DANGEROUS AND AN ESCAPE RISK.
