From all these, let us rediscover the love and the goodness, the faith and the charity that will strengthen us, individually and collectively, in meeting the challenges of everyday life and the rigors of building a national community of free and God-fearing citizens.

As a people and as a nation, we have carried our own heavy cross. We have experienced travails and pitfalls. But with trust and faith in God almighty, we have since recovered our national cohesion, improved our economy, enhanced the social well-being of our people, attained political stability, and strengthened our democracy.

It is our fervent prayer that in the annual commemoration of Holy Week, the love of Christ and the love for our fellowman shall reign supreme in our hearts, and in the hearts of all mankind.
