

# THE SHORT WING PIPER EDUCATION FOUNDATION, INC. Initial SCHOLARSHIP Information & Application New Students

The Short Wing Piper Education Foundation was established in 1994 and awarded its first scholarships in 1996. Since then, scholarships have been awarded to a select few individuals each year at the **Short Wing Piper Club** National Convention.

The purpose of this merit scholarship is to assist young people who are pursuing aviation-related careers. Applicants should be a senior in high school or high school graduate who is enrolled or plans to be enrolled in an aviation-related course of post-secondary study. The award is intended to fund tuition only, not primary flight instruction. Applicants cannot be related to a Short Wing Piper Club National Board member and must be sponsored by a SWPC member or a SWPC Chapter.

The successful scholarship applicant will be well-rounded, involved in school and community activities, show a dedication to aviation, and demonstrate through satisfactory grades, a willingness to pursue their education to a successful completion and graduation. This scholarship is only offered to those who are taking a full-time academic load, which in most cases is a minimum of 12 credit hours. An official grade transcript is required to be mailed to the SWP Education Foundation Manager upon completion of the first semester of the school year. No scholarship will be awarded if the scholarship candidate does not successfully complete at least 12 college credit hours and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Once a hard copy of your first semester's official transcript has been received and approved, your scholarship check will be mailed to your school's financial aid office.

Applications must be **received by the Education Foundation Manager** no later than **01 May** and will be reviewed by the Foundation Board at the next National Convention of the Short Wing Piper Club. All candidates will be notified of their acceptance or rejection after the National Convention, usually held in June/July.

Scholarship recipients are required to put in writing, to the SWP Education Foundation Manager, their educational **goals and progress** at least once each academic year.

- Letter of recommendation from an active Short Wing Piper Club member, or a Short Wing Piper Chapter. Include that person's name, SWPC membership number, phone number, and email address.
- Official hard copy of your high school or post-secondary school transcript. This documentation is imperative.
- Color photograph of yourself, preferably in an aviation setting. A close-up photo is requested, and without sun glasses with a digital photograph must be emailed to <a href="mailto:loureinkens@yahool.com">loureinkens@yahool.com</a>

## Applicants who hold a private pilot's license and are pursuing a flying career must include:

A photocopy of your pilot license and the last two pages of your logbook. These copies must show valid dates
and signatures to verify the pilot's identity. Copies of your logbook may not have all this information and
you may need to endorse and add additional identifying information to each page to establish your logbook's
validity. If you do not understand what is being requested, please contact the SWP Education Foundation
Director.
