#### <u>Celebrate Pollinators</u> National Pollinator Week June 20-26



#### Who are the pollinators?

They are the bees, butterflies, moths, wasps, ants, flies, beetles, birds, bats and wind. To attract these beneficials think of the basic needs of life: water, shelter and food. Choose native plants (milkweed, CA poppies, CA buckwheat) or nonnatives such as aromatic herbs (coriander, catnip, mint, parsley, lavender), annuals (marigolds, sunflower, Mexican sunflower, zinnia, cosmos), perennials (bee balm, coneflower, salvia) and trees/ shrubs (CA buckeye, manzanita, gooseberry). It may seem obvious but remember, please do not use pesticides and herbicides.

#### Are pollinators in trouble?

- Worldwide there is disturbing evidence that pollinating animals have suffered from loss of habitat, chemical misuse, introduced and invasive plant and animal species, and diseases and parasites.
- The U.S. has lost over 50% of its managed honeybee colonies over the past 10 years.

#### Why does pollination matter to us?

- Worldwide, roughly 1,000 plants grown for food, beverages, fibers, spices, and medicines need to be pollinated by animals in order to produce the goods on which we depend.
- Foods and beverages produced with the help of pollinators include: apples, blueberries, chocolate, coffee, melons, peaches, potatoes, pumpkins, vanilla, almonds, and tequila. More information:
