Homeless Outreach Team (HOT)
&
PATH (Projects for Assistance in Transitions from Homelessness)

The **Homeless Outreach Team (HOT)** is a collaborative, multidisciplinary team that goes into the community to engage with homeless adults with mental health issues and links them to support services in the community. The team is made up of a Nurse, Psychiatric Technician, Behavioral Health Therapist, a TMHA Peer Support Specialist, two TMHA Outreach Workers, and a TMHA Case Manager. The team engages with more than 200 people annually, with approximately 50 of those engaged clients receiving assessment and full mental health services in the community.

PATH (Projects for Assistance in Transition from Homelessness) consists of a dedicated outreach worker contacting and engaging homeless individuals and family members not currently connected to mainstream services.
