Nipomo Street Studios

This project has 8 individual studio apartments and is on the same campus as the Wellness Center, Hope House. Support services, shopping, bus lines, restaurants, and employment opportunities are all within easy walking distance. All units are fully furnished and complete with housewares and linens. Residential case management supports are provided to the residents as well.

What Is It Like?

This program offers independent long-term, affordable housing in a stable and supported environment for adult residents who are in treatment with San Luis Obispo Behavioral Health. Residents are helped to gain skills needed to make choices that reflect their own values, preferences and goals. Staff meets with residents on a regularly scheduled and as-needed basis. Services are adjusted to meet each resident's individual needs-intensive, moderate or low levels of support. Staff provides assistance with independent living, information and referral services, advocacy and consultation services, counseling and intervention services, and training and education.

Who Is Eligible for the Program?
