Transitions-Mental Health Association (TMHA) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to eliminating stigma and promoting recovery and wellness for people with mental illness through work, housing, community support, clinical services, homeless outreach, and family support services.

Position Summary

The Fundraising Auditor Volunteers' tasks will be:
