Dear Parent,
Greetings!

This is to inform you that as per the latest information from the CBSE the Board has introduced effective from the AY 2026- 2027, optional Advanced Level Courses in Mathematics and Science at secondary level other than the Standard Mathematics and Science which are compulsory, the details of which are given below for your clear understanding.

An orientation to this end will be given to the students of Grade 9 on 8th June, 2026 at school.

1. Standard Mathematics and Science :

- These will cover common prescribed syllabus, will be compulsory and will be studied by all students.

Subject	Nature	Syllabus	Assessment
Mathematics	Compulsory	Common Standard Content	→ 80 Marks → Exam will be in grade 10 AY 2027.2028 → Duration of Exam - 3 Hrs
Science	Compulsory	Common Standard Content	→ 80 Marks → Exam will be in grade 10 AY 2027.2028 → Duration of Exam - 3 Hrs

2. Advanced Mathematics and Advanced Science:

- This is fully optional for only those students who wish to study additional topics beyond the common syllabus.

Advanced Mathematics	Optional	Additional Content	→ 25 Marks → Exam will be in grade 10 AY 2027.2028 → Duration of Exam - 1Hr → Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOT questions)
Advanced Science	Optional	Additional Content	→ 25 Marks → Exam will be in grade 10 AY 2027.2028 → Duration of Exam - 1Hr → Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOT questions)

Important Note:

1. A candidate securing 50 % and above marks in the optional Advanced Examination shall have the following recorded in the marksheet:
 - The Advanced Level has been successfully cleared. (This text is tentative and may vary).
 - However, the marks obtained in the Advanced Examination shall not be added to the overall aggregate or total score.
 - In case a candidate secures less than the prescribed criteria, no reference to the Advanced Level shall be reflected in the marksheet.
2. This two-level structure will not apply to the internal assessments of 20 marks in Mathematics and Science conducted at the school level in Class 10.

Parent Consent Required;

1. The school has to plan and organize the Advanced Mathematics and Advanced Science effectively, we would like to assess the level of interest among students and parents.
2. **The school will be able to offer additional guidance classes for Advanced Mathematics and Science only if a sufficient number of students opt for these subjects. Therefore, we request parents to indicate their child's interest.**
3. Please note that if the number of students opting for the Advanced Level subjects is very low, the school may not be able to conduct separate classes. In such cases, students who wish to appear for the Advanced examinations will be expected to prepare independently. However, subject teachers will provide support through worksheets, reference materials, and additional notes whenever possible.
4. **Kindly submit your consent through the Google Form [Link](#) on or before Tuesday, 9th June 2026. Requests received after the deadline will not be considered.**
