Dear Students,

We are delighted to inform you that our school is proudly organizing **ARTISTA 2026-27** on **Wednesday, 07 October 2026 for the Girls and Thursday, 08 October 2026 for the Boys** during school hours. Students who wish to participate may obtain the Google Form from their respective class teachers and submit it on or before **04 September 2026**. Participants are encouraged to prepare thoroughly and showcase their talents to the best of their abilities.

Artista Drawing Competition Rules are given below.

- Artwork should not display the participant's name, class, division, or similar details. Such information must be included only in the registration form.
- Participants are not permitted to leave the venue during the competition.
- Participants are advised to review the theme attached to the circular and prepare well for the competition.
- Participants in Poster Making and Newspaper Collage Making will receive 1.5 hours; all other competitions will be conducted for 1 hour respectively.
- Students in the **Junior and Senior Categories** may participate in a maximum of **4 items**, including **individual and group events**.
- All participants must follow the guidelines for their respective competitions as per the given list.

ITEM	RULES
Little Artists Coloring Competition	• The picture will be provided on the day of the event. • Participants may use crayons, color pencils, or pastels. • Judging will be based on neatness, creativity, and overall presentation. • Students should bring their own crayons and color pencils
Little Artists Painting Competition	• Students should bring their own paints, materials and an A3-size sheet (11.7 × 16.5 inches). • Participants must complete their drawing and painting during the competition time. • Evaluation will focus on color blending, neatness, contrast, and finishing. • Required materials include pencils, erasers, color palette, brushes, water, and tissues.

Watercolor Competition (Sub Junior Junior Senior)	- Required materials include watercolors, palette, brushes, water for mixing, and tissues. - Required: White chart paper – A3 size (11.7 × 16.5 inches). - Judgement criteria include relevance to the theme, originality, creativity, artistic composition, and the message conveyed through the artwork.
Acrylic Painting Competition (Sub Juniors Juniors Seniors)	- Required materials include acrylic colors, palette, brushes, water for color mixing, and tissues. - Required: White chart paper – A3 size (11.7 × 16.5 inches). - Judgement criteria include relevance to the theme, originality, creativity, artistic composition, and the message conveyed through the artwork.
Creative Craft from Waste (Sub Juniors Juniors Seniors)	- Acceptable waste materials include tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute items, all types of plastic, e-waste, or any second-hand materials meant for disposal. - Any material not classified as a waste product or second-hand item will not be accepted. - Use of materials that may cause injury or health hazards is strictly prohibited. - Only original work created during the competition will be accepted; ready or semi-finished models are not allowed. - Judging will be based on innovation, creativity, effective utilization of resources, artistic composition and design, eco-friendliness, practical usefulness, minimal waste generation, and overall presentation.
Poster Making Competition (Sub Junior Junior Senior) GROUP EVENT	- A poster is a visual presentation that combines text and images to effectively create awareness on issues of public interest. - Poster making is a House-wise group event, with each team consisting of two members. - The poster must be made on A3-size chart paper (11.7 × 16.5 inches) with a 0.5-inch margin drawn using a black pen or marker. - Participants may use pencil, crayon, watercolour, acrylic paint, or other suitable colouring materials to make the poster. - Use of photographs, wires, 3D materials, or print-outs is not permitted; the poster must be original and handmade. - Judgement will be based on relevance to the theme, originality, creativity, artistic composition, clarity of message, and effectiveness of communication.
Newspaper Collage Competition (Junior Senior) GROUP EVENT	- Collage making involves combining and pasting different pictures on a single sheet of paper to create one complete picture. - Poster making is a House-wise group event, with each team consisting of two members. - Students must bring their own mats for seating and for placing the sheet and other materials. - The collage must be made on a sheet of size 52 × 37 cm. - Teams must submit a single-page write-up on the theme of their

	collage on A4 paper, clearly mentioning the chest number. • Participants must bring all required materials, including white chart paper, newspapers or magazines, glue, scissors, sketch pens, colours, etc. • A team may be disqualified for exceeding the allotted time, deviating from the theme, or providing an unsatisfactory explanation to the judges.
<i>Pencil Drawing Competition (Junior Senior)</i>	• The drawing must be done on pencil drawing paper or chart paper of size 25 × 35 cm. • Acceptable materials include pencils, colour pencils, graphite and pastel pencils, black or white pens, charcoal sticks or powder, chalk, rulers, erasers, compasses, protractors, and drawing paper/supports. • Use of stencils is not permitted in this competition. • Artworks will be judged on relevance to the theme, originality, creativity, artistic composition, and effectiveness in conveying the intended message.
