- Advise the inter-institutional working group on process design (workflow definition, technical specifications, contract requirements (e.g. regarding server hosting and maintenance)); the working group consists of the Ministry of Labor, the SENUM (governmental digitization agency), external service providers and GIZ
- Support process management and the interaction of the various stakeholders
- Support the training of the different user groups (clients/ business owners, employees)
- Support the establishment of decentralized service centers for platform use
