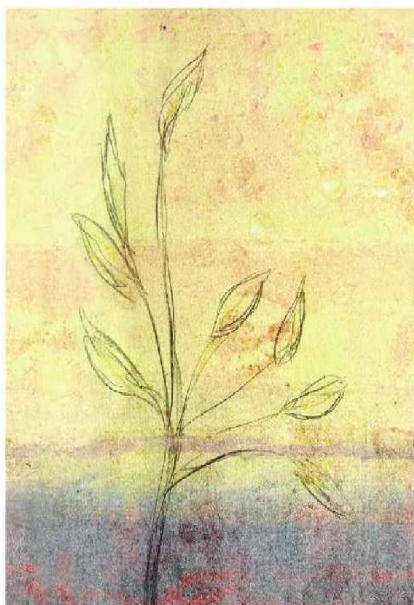

Grapes for our Roussanne (roo-SAHN) wine come from the Oswald Vineyard in Brownfield, Texas, where the warm days and cool nights of the high desert intensify the wines' flavors of pear, pineapple and honey.

This rich, full-bodied dry wine was cold-fermented in stainless steel tanks to retain its fresh fruit aromas, and was bottled without oak to preserve its varietal flavors. Complex and layered, our Roussanne wine is delicious when served young and will also age well for years to come.
