Château Fonréaud is located in the heart of the Haut-Médoc area on the appellation Lustrac-Médoc. The Château was built in the typical style of the 19th century. The vineyard enjoys a privileged location on well exposed slopes of the Puy de Menjon, the highest point in the Médoc. It is cultivated respecting the natural environment and the particular characteristics of the terroir. The soil is composed with gravels on clay and limestone subsoil, offering perfect conditions for an early ripening of the three varieties. The wine is aged in barrels, providing the perfect balance between the strength of the Cabernet Sauvignon, the intense fruit of the Merlot and the spiciness of the Petit Verdot. The elegance and charm of Château Fonréaud reflects the spirit of the owner.
