The label depicts a piece of jewelry previously used as an adornment by the Mapuches, who are local indigenous Chileans.

This wine is made from Carménère grapes grown between the Chimbarongo Creek and the Tinguirica River on the Maquis Estate in central Colchagua Valley. The three-meter-deep alluvial soil contains 30% clay, which produces Carménère with excellent volume, ripeness, complex aromas and great length.

This Carménère was picked the first week in March due to a long, dry summer with temperatures almost 3°C higher than average, allowing for an earlier harvest. The wine displays a good balance of freshness and concentration.
