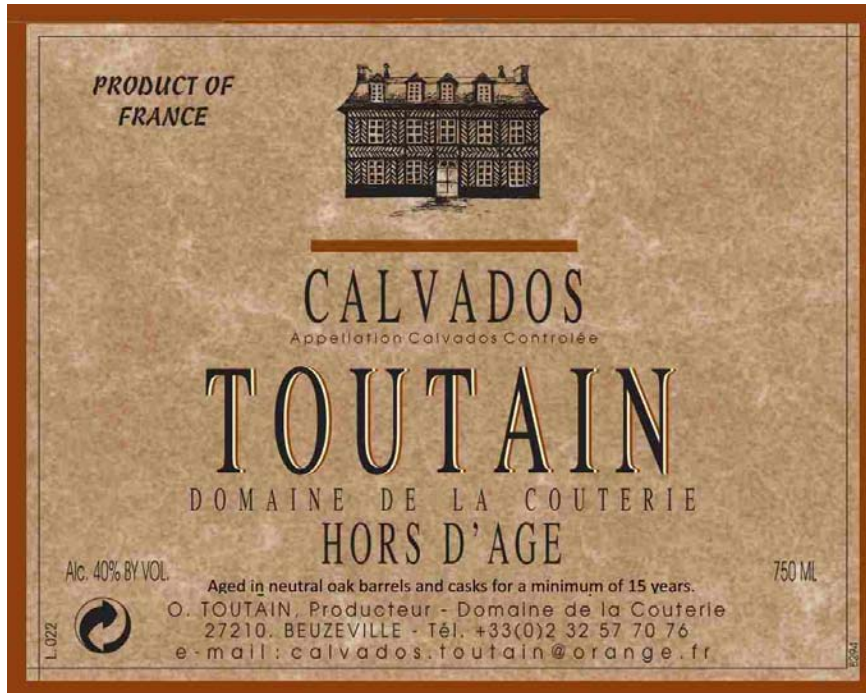

For five generations Toutains have made artisan Calvados at the house pictured on their label. Today, Maxime and his mother Corinne manage the family affairs, cultivating 35 Normandy cider varieties in 60 acres of traditional, low-density orchards. No chemicals are used from tree to bottle. Their range is based upon a *minimum* aging period in casks: Fine (3 years); Vieux (8 years); Hors d'Age (15 years); Vieille Réserve (30 years); and Très Vieille Réserve (45 years).
