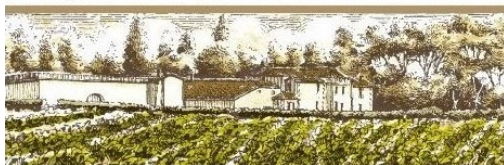
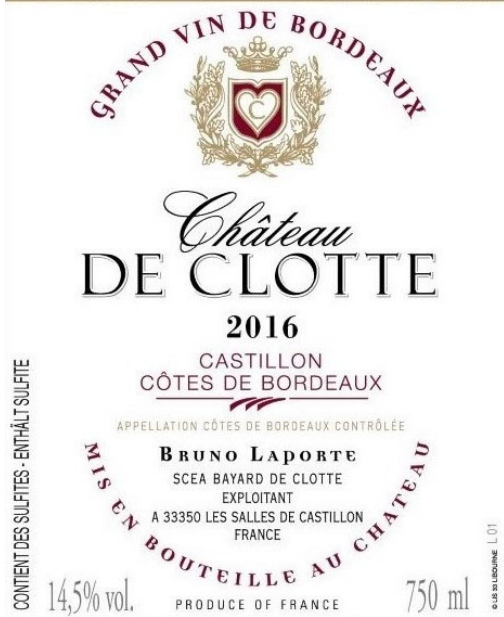

APPELLATION CÔTES DE BORDEAUX CONTRÔLÉE

Built in 1782, Château de Clotte is a Louis XV building in the shape of a chartreuse with one-storey high and a central body topped by a pediment. The place was chosen for its soil and subsoil very favourable to plant vine. Thus, this jewel rises in the centre of a setting formed by wooded hills, whose dark green pines contrast in spring with the soft green of the vine. The property, which consists of 65 hectares in one piece, includes 20 hectares of vines, grouped on the best terroirs.

In 2002, Bruno Laporte bought the property from the Guerret-Denies family. He will carry out major renovation and modernisation work on the winemaking and maturing cellars in order to position Château de Clotte's wines among the very best in the appellation.
