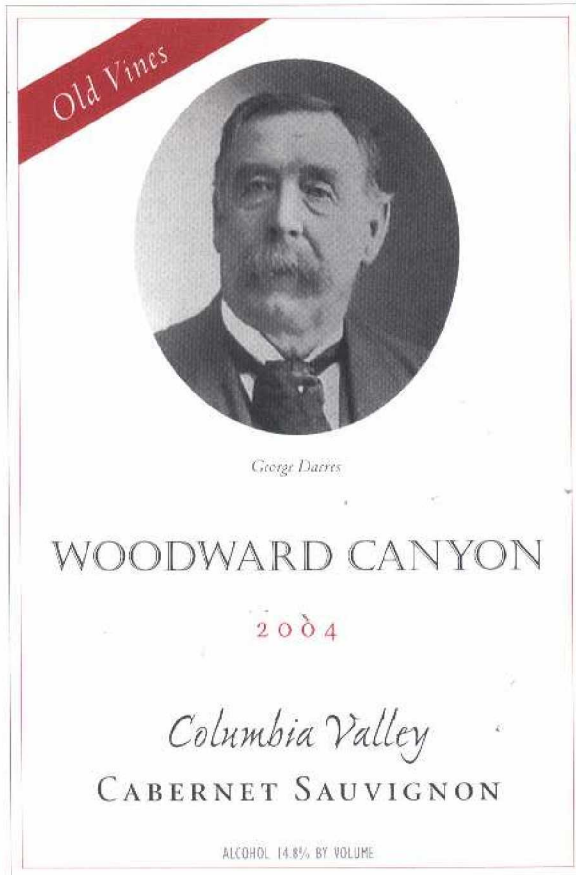

George Dacres was born in Ireland in 1829 and decided to try his fortunes in the new world in 1849, landing first in New York then moving on to California in 1852. After five years he moved to Washington State and worked as an Assistant Surveyor, then as a packer into the mining camps in the region. In 1875 he turned his attention to farming, amassing 3,000 acres in the Walla Walla area. In 1899 he erected the Dacres Hotel at 4th and Main – the finest and best equipped hotel in the city. Dacres survived two wives who bore him three children. Mr. Dacres was recognized in the community for his integrity and interest in the well-being of the City as evidenced by his service on the city council. He passed away January 5, 1902.
