You are holding wine from the second vintage of Cheval des Andes - an Argentinean joint venture between Bodega Terrazas de los Andes (Moet Hennessy), Mendoza and Chateau Cheval Blanc in St. Emilion within Bordeaux. Two highly-renowned winemakers, respectively, Roberta de la Mota of Terrazas, and Pierre Lurton of Cheval Blanc joined forces in Argentina to create a seamless wine of great sophistication.

Malbec is fast becoming the grape varietal of prestige in Argentina, and it had been one of the prominent grape varieties of Saint-Emilion before the vineyards of Saint-Emilion were destroyed by phylloxera, a root louse in the 1860s. This vintage of Cheval des Andes contains Cabernet Sauvignon (56%), Malbec (40%), and a dash of Petit Verdot (4%). The Malbec dominates the aromas and flavour profiles, offering richness and a viscosity that you will find generous and rich on the palate. Aeration will enhance the experience.
