Benbournie, in South Australia's mid north, was settled in 1853 by Catholic German friends of local priest, Father Kranewitter. The tiny settlement comprised about 15 mud huts surrounding a Roman Catholic chapel.

The small community's optimism was built on copper mining, but the industry's decline signalled its demise before the turn of the century. All that remains today are a few ancient grape vines, fig and almond trees.

Jim Barry's friend and gentleman neighbour, Duncan McRae Wood, sold him 70 acres on Benbournie Road in 1964 and, on this prime land, Jim planted his first vineyard to Cabernet Sauvignon.

The 2002 Benbournie is a refined Cabernet Sauvignon, with complex aromas of cinnamon, nutmeg and rosemary. The palate shows seamlessly integrated blackcurrant and mint flavours, with ripe silky tannins giving the wine excellent dimensional structure.
