The airbase was sold to the Miller Family and for four generations they have farmed the surrounding area. The first wine grapes were planted at 'Airfield' prior to 1970, and today we are proud to bring you wines made from our best vineyards.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES: Harvest was during the first November freeze where temperatures reached twelve degrees Fahrenheit. At harvest, grapes equalled 39.5% sugar, but are perfectly balanced with adequate acidity. Flavors are that of apricots, and orange blossoms. This wine pairs perfectly with vanilla ice cream and warm apple pie. Enjoy!

Harvest: 39.5% sugar by weight. Fermentation: 10% residual sugar by weight.
