The term "Single Barrel" means that the whiskey in that bottle all came from one individual barrel. Whiskey is typically made by vatting together many barrels from different years and aging warehouses. Single barrel bourbon is a special treat. It comes from hand selected barrels that were identified by the head distiller as the best. Since no two barrels age exactly the same, there can be subtle, interesting differences from barrel to barrel.

.36 Single Barrel is also a fascinating barrel experiment. This bourbon is the exact same recipe as our Ranger Creek .36 Small Caliber Series. The only difference is that **.36 Single Barrel** was aged in more traditional large barrels instead of innovative small barrels. The larger barrels take years to mature and bring out subtle differences in the character of the bourbon. Try them side-by-side to see what similarities and differences you can distinguish.
