THE GLENDULLAN DISTILLERY WAS FOUNDED IN 1897 HAS CREATED MAGNIFICENT WHISKIES FOR OVER A HUNDRED YEARS USING ONLY THE PUREST INGREDIENTS INCLUDING WATER FROM THE CONVAL HILL SPRINGS. PATRONS OF THE DISTILLERY INCLUDED KING EDWARD VII WHO CONSIDERED GLENDULLAN HIS FAVORITE WHISKY. LOCATED IN A BEAUTIFUL WOODED VALLEY, GLENDULLAN WAS ONE OF THE ORIGINAL SEVEN DISTILLERIES ESTABLISHED IN DUFFTOWN, BANFFSHIRE IN THE SPEYSIDE REGION OF SCOTLAND.

INITIALLY QUITE LIGHT, BUT EXPANDING AND GROWING OVER TIME. MALT, POPCORN, FRESHLY CUT HERBS AND JUST A FAINT HINT OF COCONUT WITH AN AFTERTASTE OF RICH COCONUT WHICH APPEARS VERY QUICKLY AS A MASSIVE RUSH OF FLAVOR.
