After 25 years of the Saintsbury motto, "if it's red it's Pinot Noir, if it's white it's Chardonnay" we decided to take a fork in the road. Pinot noir is hard enough for any three winemakers—why would we undertake another challenge? The short version—Syrah is a great variety with a long history in France and the New World, and very few of the New World versions are from cool sites. We have found two exposed hilltop vineyards possessing thin soils, good exposure and long growing seasons. Both are just over the Carneros line on adjacent hilltops, one in Sonoma Coast and this one in Sonoma Valley. From these grapes, we have made two "Saintsbury" Syrahs—brimming with aromas of white pepper and charcuterie, and a more compact and elegant profile than is typical of wines from warmer climates.
